So I ordered one from Amazon, (2 for \$10) and it was delivered the next day around 2:00. Unsoldered the bad one, soldered in


C21 - Nauru




There's always something to fix.

But on a more positive note, 6M season is fast approaching. We're starting to see more openings, especially south and west. Eventually Europe will start to open up for us.


