TO8FH - Mayotte



4W8X, Timor-Leste will be activated in November 2023 by a team of 20+ skillful and highly experienced DXers and Contesters from Germany, Austria, Poland, Hungary and England under leadership of Lagunaria DX Group.

Highlighting today: Working North America and South America

During our 4W1A scouting trip in April we experienced how easy it is to work into Europe and Asia, but how difficult it is to reach North America and South America. Signals from/to to the Northern US/Canada East Coast and a large part of South America must pass through the respective polar regions. It is very challenging to reach W1, W2, VE1, VE2, VE9, VO1, VO2, VY2, other countries in the Arctic and a large part of South America. South America is even more challenging: the terrain is rising in that direction, with mountains as high as almost 3000m.

4W8X will have the right antennas and operating concept to be heard well in the Americas – on all bands and at the right times. We'll pay special attention to "difficult areas" and – rest assured – we'll work hard to get as many NA and SA stations in our log as possible.





Photo below shows Mike, KN4EEI and all the gear in one place. No tents, no latrines/toilet, no showers: minimum impact. We have just completed changing the main antenna coax: from cheap stuff to high quality pre-assemble coax with great connectors, courtesy of DX Engineering. Interference gone! 160 m antenna is seen in the background on the right. On the left is the 40 – 10 m FT8 antenna.





[AUGUST 25] – We have three stations on the air: One local and two remote ones, of which, one is FT8 and the other CW. The local station has been on CW so far but we are planning to start SSB later today. Conditions on the higher bands were good yesterday, especially on 20m. On 40 EU signals were weak around 1800. 30m was good most of the night.

160: We have a very good TX antenan for 160/80. We got on TB around 0930 Z. There were very few callers from NA, but JA-s were calling from about 1000 Z (their SS) and some were very strong. Overall, 160 m activity was low and we QSY'd to higher bands for the rest of the night. The NA signals that came through were mostly strong. An encouraging sign.

160 tonight from 0515, listening for EU until about 0600, when we will try 80m for EU. This time of the year the window to EU is narrow on 160 and 80. But based on experience at VP6A, which was in June, EU is possible just at their SR, especially on 80. We will be here until Sept 10, by which time the window will widen some and low band conditions will likely improve. For NA (and JA) we will be on from 0930 and work as long as there are callers.

HAMCLOCK



I've always been interested in HAMCLOCK - a computer based clock displaying time in GMT, local time, a world grey line map and solar parameters.

Below is a shot of my 22" monitor displaying the running software.



The software will run on a PC and a Raspberry-Pi. I've often thought of using one of my Pi's, but the setup is cumbersome on a Pi. But then I came across an advertisement for an 'inovato QUAD-RA' computer. This little guy is little! About 4" square and 3/4 inches hi, only costs \$34.95 (plus \$10 shipping) and had Hamclock preloaded (along with other software). No muss. No fuss. Hook up a monitor, keyboard and mouse and your all set.



Here is an excerpt from their webpage:

Not just a raw board, Quadra is a complete modern Linux computer that can be used as a server or light-use desktop. It includes the case, heatsink, power adapter and HDMI cable. Just plug into a TV or monitor and a keyboard/mouse. No SD card needed as the OS (Debian Bullseye 64-bit) is pre-flashed in internal memory. A great option instead of Raspberry Pi when you don't need the 40-pin I/O header or want something more affordable that doesn't require assembly.





V4 - St. Kitts


