Peter 1 Island

There is also plans for Peter I Island in progress. We have secured a vessel, and we're now building a team of 19 operators that will go to Peter I Island in February 2026 and stay there for 14 days. The vessel is a proper Antarctica vessel with 2 helicopters, two Expedition leaders and with all permits needed. We are working closely with the Norwegian Polar Institute to obtain the landing permit. A website will be created and more information about Peter I Island DX-pedition will be released later. Fundraising is expected to start 2024

Team leader Ken LA7GIA – Co-leader Adrian KO8SCA, Co-leader Cezar VE3LYC and Co-leader Dave WD5COV. Media Officer and WW Pilot Steve Hass N2AJ.

Because we are running the two DXpeditions through the same organization there exist synergies as for the equipment, logistics and resources committed to execute these.

XW - Laos

XW4DX operator F4BKV, Vincent, "will be operating XW4KV regularly up to mid 2024 on 15m and 10m bands with low power, (100w and dipoles antennas for both bands)". Listen for him on FT8 and when propagation is good on SSB.

6M Woooos!

As reported by Bernie, W3UR in the Daily DX for December 4th "K8SIX, Al, noted a 6M opening to Europe from 1551-1606Z. He copied EA2KR, EA1DR, CT1ILT, CO2QU and EA1DFP. Unfortunately, he had to make a run to the bank for his wife, otherwise would have seen the JT Alert and would have rushed to his hamshack.

VU7 - Lakshadweep

W4VKU, Krish, has shipped the gear for the upcoming, December 4-10, VU7A DXpedition to the Lakshadweep Islands. The equipment is being shipped from the Indian West Coast. On 160 FT8 VU7A will be "using MSHV and Multi-answer auto sequencing on [the] non-standard FT8" frequency 1836 KHz and MSHV will be "set to answer the callers, by the distance. So, the farthest first". Krish will be using an Acom 1000 and a vertical.

CY9C - St. Paul Is.

WA4DAN and team plan on returning to CY0 - St. Paul Is in 2024. They expect a permit from The Department of Fisheries and Oceans for late August into early September 2024.

ET - Ethiopia

K4ZW, Ken, has booked flights, hoping conditions hold for the 10M Contest. He will be at the ET3AA club station but expects the club members to do most of he operating. Outside the weekend event he plans to look at options for low band operations, and "deal more effectively with the awful noise." Then, W9XY and K4ZW and possibly a third operator will be at ET3AA January 12-20.

T32 - East Kiribati

Preparations are in full swing for next DXpedition by the Rebel DX Group. 90% of the T32TT activity will be on digital, "if you like it or not", they say. In order "to make more digi fans happy" they are trying a new "software experiment" with up to "10 streaming signals on each band" for FT4 and FT8. The Rebels say, "You will be able to contact T32TT on normal mode and F/H mode using any software you wish." T32TT will use both standard frequencies and dedicate FT4 and FT8 frequencies. Plans are to have 12 digital stations, two CW and one SSB, beginning December 5.

ZL7 - Chatham Is.

ZL1CAP, ZL1LDP, ZL1OV, and ZL3SSB will be active here next month. Activity will be SSB and maybe FT8 on 80 to 10M.

Z6 - Kosovo

S53BB, Boris, has been in Pristina, Kosovo since November using the call Z68BB. Listen for him on CW and FT8 on 7 through 28 MHz until April 2024. THE LONG PATH

VU7 - Andaman & Nicobar Islands

W4VKU, Krish plans to be on the air from VU7 starting at 0001 local time December 5, which is December 4, 1831Z. He plans 160-6M FT8 and SSB, until December 10. He says he "may stay longer but it depends on the demand for VU7 on the air. 702 - Socotra Is.




Vlad, OK2WX will be active from Socotra island, Yemen as 7O2WX during January 25 to February 12, 2024. Focus on low bands (160, 80 and 40m). Equipment: Elecraft K4, Icom 7300 + amplifier. Monoband verticals for each of 160, 80 & 40 and Spiderbeam 5 band for HF. A log will be available online. Participation in the CQ 160m DX Contest CW. QSL via IZ8CCW.


Vlad has posted a survey of preferred bands and modes on the DXpedition website. If you are missing some bands and modes from Yemen, he can focus on them. He also mentions approved PA (amplifier) available, on upper bands 3-4 el yagi will be used, and monoband 18m verticals for low bands 160 and 80m.

7P8EI - Lesotho

EIDXG are delighted to formally announce their plans for another new adventure. Following on from the success of 9N7EI, 7Q7EI, 5V7EI and this year's V26EI, the team are excited to bring you 7P8EI as they head off to Lesotho in March 19-30. The 15 man team will be QRV on all bands and modes from 160m through 10m. Website and full announcement coming soon.



VK0DS - Antarctica



From December 2023 to November 2024, David VK2JDS will occasionally be active from Davis Station, Antarctica using the callsign VK0DS. He hopes to be QRV on HF bands and will also try 2m EME using a single 12el yagi and 100 watts.


3D2AD, 5W8A & ZK3M


