Speaking of new countries to get, I see there will be another DXpedition to Bouvet. This group has contracted to be on the island for 21 days and around the island for 30 days. I was not able to get them the last time. I started to copy them many times on FT8 but it never complete. I'm excited that maybe this time I will have a chance since they will setup stations on a different part of the island and a dedicated camp for North America (low angle take off) so maybe I can get them on Phone, Digital (FT8/CW). This same DXpedition will also go to Peter I Island in 2026 and stay there for 14 days. The vessel is a proper Antarctica vessel with 2 helicopters, two Expedition leaders and with all permits needed. Lots of good DXing coming in the next fewyears for operators like myself that still need these.

I have made progress on countries/entities that I have made contact with. Last reported I was at 267 contacts to different countries/entities. 233 are confirmed. I am now at 269 with 234 confirmed. Even more progress!! I need to send a few cards out or get on Club Log and get some of these rarer entities confirmed!


Coming in late February / early March we will have the vessel inspection to verify its seaworthiness for the long journey from the Falklands to Bouvet. At this time, we must make the first \$100,000 deposit presuming the boat passes professional inspection so funding is time critical, please help if you can, with whatever you can.

We will also be procuring the custom-made tents to survive the harsh environment found from our previous activation of Bouvet as well as proper antenna systems. As earlier posted, we have a commitment from RF-KITS for five of their newest 2KW solid state amplifiers. Thanks to them for such a generous offer!

Up to June we will complete the testing of the remote equipment on a South Pacific expedition by some of our friends in the DX community and begin training the chosen remote operators. Note that the remote will be FT modes – all SSB and CW will be from the island only.


Without the help from the amateur radio community, the above calendar would not have been possible.


