# **ZC4 UK Sovereign Base Area on Cyprus**

G3ZAY, Martin, tells us, "A group from Cambridge University Wireless Society will be QRV from the UK Sovereign Base Area on Cyprus as ZC4UW from 2-7 January with a maximum of 4 stations. The team will be QRV with 400W on 160-10 in principle - though little propagation is expected above 21MHz. Antennas will be verticals and the main modes will be CW and SSB. The group will not be on FT8 or FT4. Logs will be uploaded to Club Log and LOTW so please use Club Log OQRS.

SV/A - Mount Athos SV2RSG/A, Monk Iakovos (Jacob), was found on Friday on 20 and 40 meters CW. On Saturday he was on 14.038 MHz between 1000 and 1915Z. On Sunday he was reported on 14.027 MHz between 0900 and 1000Z. He's located at the Holy Monastery Koutloumousiou. As of October 28 this operation has not been accredited by DXCC, so you will want to work him first and worry later about the paperwork. QSL via SV1GRM. (credit to "The Weekly DX")

## H40 Solomon Is.

Grant KZ1W and Rob N7QT will activate H40 Temotu Province, Solomon Islands, Nov 14th through Nov 28th, 2019. Awaiting permission to operate as H40TT, otherwise each will operate under their own call: H40TT Rob and H40KT Grant.

10m – 160m CW/SSB/FT8/RTTY. They will focus on the low bands to regions where H40 is most needed. They will "follow the sun" please respect their calls into specific regions. Operating frequencies listed on QRZ.com H40TT or H40KT

## VK9—Cocos



They expect "modest propagation," especially on the high bands, so they expect to be very active on 160 and 80 CW and FT8 and will also try 80 SSB in the DX window, aware of the
