Bio for Michael Kirkhart

Michael Kirkhart is an electronics engineer, hardware hacker, and amateur radio operator (callsign KD8OBA). A chance encounter at the 2011 Detroit Maker Faire led him to attend the 1 st Annual hackerSPACE workshop in Lexington, Kentucky, where met Morehead State University Professor Robert Twiggs, one of the creators of the CubeSat. During the workshop, he inquired how folks outside the university community could participate in the design, construction, and operation of asmall satellite. In an example of "be careful what you wish for", he found himself working with university students and other outside advisers on the construction of a new class of satellite called a PocketOube. The end result of this collaboration were two PocketOubes: T-LogoOube. built by students at Sonoma State University and Morehead State University, and \$50SAT, built by Michael and the other advisers. Both were launched on November 21, 2013, and were operational shortly after launch.

Upcoming DXpeditions

There is still a chance for 3Y0I to activate Bouvet Island.

Other promised activity in January are ZC4UW, E44RU, VK9NK and TI9C followed by VP8/VP8DXU (South Orkney) in February.

Later in 2020 you can expect KH8S, T30, TU, FJ, KH4, CY0C to name a few. 2020 looks like an exciting year for DXers.

9J - Zambia

Since 2016 ZS6JBS, Bernd "Jerry" Sinner, has been living near Mufulira a town in the Copperbelt Province some 300 kilometers north of Lusaka. On Friday December 13th he was issued the call 9J2BS. "I am restricted with antennas where I live as it is a protected wildlife area, so wire antennas in trees are the order of the day", says Jerry. He is operating a Kenwood TS480SAT while home and an FT-857D when mobile. From home he uses a ZS6BKW version of a G5RV up in a tree some 14 meters above the ground and when mobile a 56" whip Tarheel II. He can be found on 20 meters SSB running 100 watts on or near 14.200 MHz in the 1330 to 1530Z time frame. Jerry plans to stay in 9J for the next five years, with a hopeful move in about six months to Mufulira and which time he hopes to "put up decent antennas". QSL via LoTW.

J2 - Djibouti

DL7DF, Sigi, and company have announced plans for their March 4-16 DXpedition to Djibouti. Plans are to have three stations for activity on 1.8 through 28 MHz on SSB, CW and digital modes. They will have an Elecraft K2 and three IC-7300's along with four amplifiers. As for antennas they will have a vertical on 160 and 80 meters, loops on 40, 30, 20, 15 and 10 meters, and a Spiderbeam for 20 through 10 meters. They will also have a Beverage for receive on the low bands. The team will include: DJ6TF, Tom; DK1BT, Manfred; DL4WK, Wolf; DL6SAK, Annette; DL7BO, Tom; DL7DF, Sigi; DL7UFR, Frank; and SP3DOI, Leszek. DF3CB, Bernd, will be the team's pilot station. QSL via DL7DF.

HRH Prince Dasho Jigyel Ugyen Wangchuck is the half-brother of the King of Bhutan. Three years ago Zorro trained His Royal Highness. The Prince "is always busy" and has been so this week for Bhutan's 112th National Day. Over the last three days Zorro had multiple meetings with HRH Prince Dasho Jigyel Ugyen Wangchuck. Zorro is very excited that HRH "will finally [be able to] participate" in the A5 activities. Zorro says, "Dec 17th, A5B will operate with the permission of HRH starting 20m SSB". This is an historical moment for Bhutan and Amateur Radio.

After submission of a copy of Alan's license, ARRL has issued us a new LoTW certificate for the use of this call from South Orkney for the duration of our expedition.

2019 DXCC Year End Review – by Joe Reisert,

Looking ahead to 2020 and Beyond: SC 24 is definitely on its last legs. Solar activity is near minimum as we wait for the official Solar Minimum and the start of SC 25, probably during 2020. DX means different things to each DXer. Some DXers chase the DXCC Honor Roll, the DXCC Challenge or the DX Marathon. I'd estimate from the latest DXCC mixed listings on the ARRL "DX Standing" list that there are well over 2,000 persons worldwide that have confirmed all 340 on the present DXCC entities list. Fernando, EA8AK now has an amazing 3264 entities to lead the DXCC Challenge. More than 185 DXers have now achieved the very difficult DXCC Challenge 3000 level.

The top 6 meter station, LZ2CC has an amazing 280 entities. There are only about 20 NA stations to break the 6 meter 150 entities level. K2ZD has 209 and W7GJ has 204 confirmed. 6 meter EME is being more frequently used by major DXpeditions and is now a very important factor for leading North American 6 meter DXers.

It's time to improve your 20 and 17 meter as well as your 80 and 160 meter antennas. Then there are the never ending DX Contests, DX Marathon, DXCC Challenge and IOTA chasing. There are lots of things to do. Don't let the airways die for lack of activity. HF radio conditions on the midbands are still fair but improving on the lower bands. Stay active and join the fun. Also don't forget to support the various DX Foundations around the world that help make DXpeditions possible!

Solar Cycle 25 Forecast

The following Solar Cycle 25 Forecast Update is from the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) Space Weather Prediction Center (SWPC) website.

"The NOAA/NASA co-chaired, international panel to forecast Solar Cycle 25 released their latest forecast for Solar Cycle 25. The forecast consensus: a peak in July, 2025 (+/- 8 months), with a smoothed sunspot number (SSN) of 115. The panel agreed that Cycle 25 will be average in intensity and similar to Cycle 24."

"Additionally, the panel concurred that solar minimum between Cycles 24 and 25 will occur in April, 2020 (+/- 6 months). If the solar minimum prediction is correct, this would make Solar Cycle 24 the 7th longest on record (11.4 years)."


KH2 - GUAM

NH2KY appears to be a planned multiop effort, March 26-31 in the CQ WW WPX phone contest. Outside the weekend event the ops plan to be on FT8, FT4, SSB, RTTY, PSK, JT65A and CW on 160-6M. Organizers request a direct QSL via JR3QFB's QRZ.com address with SAE and one IRC or two USD. Bureau cards from Japanese ops, send to JR3QFB through JARL. The rest of the world, go through the regular bureau routes. They also plan eQSL, LoTW and Club Log availability for QSLs.
