Ten members of the Northern Corridor Radio Group are planning an activation of Cocos Keeling



- VK9C between March 16th and 23rd 2021. The operation is vacation style although having said that, with 10 of us on the team, we expect to be quite active, but possibly not 24/7. K3LR's Presentation

Tim, K3LR has spent 30+ years building his contest station. His antenna farm is amazing, especially his 40M capabilities. He has the world's tallest and largest 40M antenna array. And his receive antennas are a Hi-Z 8 circle array for 160M, a pair of 4square on 80M which gives 3db gain over just a single array, and dedicated 4 square arrays for 40, 20, 15 and 10 meters. Because these are vertically polarized from the yagis they allow simultaneous listening while transmitting on the same band! A real advantage for searching for multipliers.

Power failures during contests? No problem with his 50kW back-up generator.

He has hosted many top operators from around the world to enjoy multi-multi contests. Team Exuberance were hosted in 2019 and the young participants won!

Interestingly there are NO wall warts on Tim's property. Only linear power supplies! All cell phone chargers are confiscated as soon as the operator arrives on site and returned before they leave!

Many interesting questions from the audience were fielded by Tim. I learned a lot from Tim's presentation and I know many in the audience did as well.

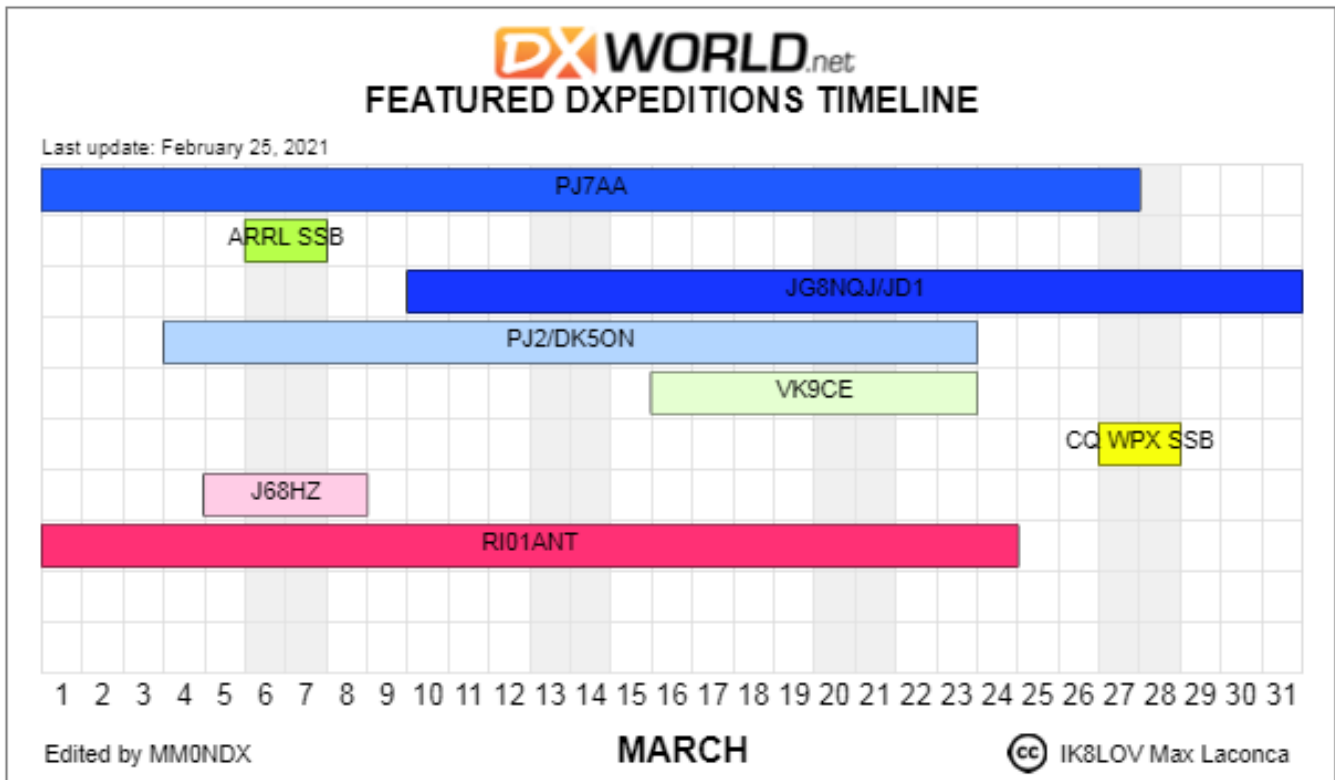

FT-8 Boring

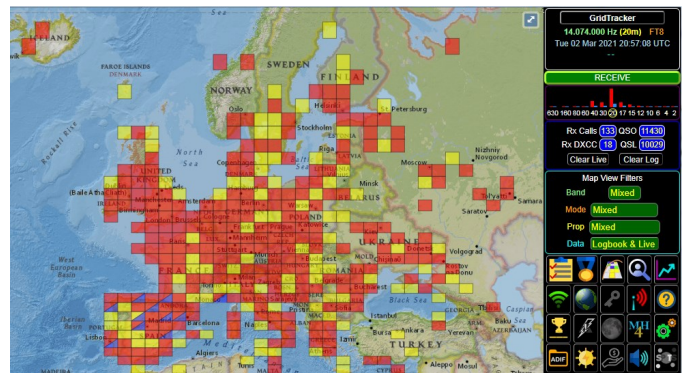

Whow. Don't get me wrong. I'm not saying that FT-8 is boring. I meant to say that I was bored at the start of this year and was looking for something different to do during this period of pandemia.

So I decided to explore FT-8 in a more serious way than in the past. I decided to see if I could work 10 FT-8 contacts a day for a year for a total of 3650 QSO's in 2021.

Well! One thing led to another. It was fun creating pile-ups of 4, 5, 7 at a time. Trying to keep them all sorted and not denying the deserving a QSO with a rare Canadian grid square at times was a challenge.

But as time went on, I was curious as to how many grid squares, DXCC entities, USA counties I had worked as the numbers started to climb. And then I found a program called "GridTracker". A FREE program that tracks all that I wanted and has a marvellous graphical display.



Here's a screen shot of Europe from Grid Tracker. Red indicates confirmed grids with LOTW, yellow indicates worked but not yet confirmed. GridTracker is certainly worth while exploring. Lots of YouTube videos on how to set it up and use it.

So how have I done? Well from January 1st to March 2nd: 2815 FT-8 QSO's, worked 938 grids, confirmed 696 grids, 128 DXCC entities confirmed and 141 worked on 160, 80,40,20,17,15 and 12M.

I think I'll have 3650 QSO's by end of March!
