## S2 - Bangladesh

S21DX with operators S21AM, S21RC and S21D, will be doing an island operation, Manpura Island, AS-140, scheduled for December 16-26, 2021. S21RC, Fazlay Rabby, says they will have a Yaesu FT-600 and FT-757GX2, 100 watts, to a three-band beam, a multiband dipole, and vertical for 40. They plan to be on 40, 20, 15 and 10 SSB and FT8. Fazlay says they will be on a remote part of the island with no commercial power, which will help avoid interference. They will power their station with heavy duty batteries and a 2KW generator to top up the batteries.

## 3Y0I - Bouvet & 3D2 Islands

Hello folks

Things are going slow during pandemic, but we are going forward with our plans. After visiting South Africa 2 months ago, we can confirm that all equipment is ready for this year 2021 (November - December) Bouvet operation part 2. We really hope this time wild ocean will cooperate with us.

In the mean time we are finally going back to our Rebel vessel located in Fiji. Plans are to go back to Conway Reef for 3 weeks, Rotuma for 3 to 4 weeks and some very rare iotas around 3d2 zone. We will be testing some our new ideas to operate 5 different stations on FT8 (FOX & HUND) at the same time by 1 operator. (NO ROBOTS INVOLVED!!!!) This will be video recorded. Some stationary test went very promising.

This (HATE OR LOVE) mode will defenently help some small pistols to get rare DXCCs in to the log. Just to remind you, our last trip to Conway (operated by 2 ops. Tack JE1CKA and Dom 3z9dx) did over 33.828 Qso's in less than 8 days. That is world record for QSO/DAY/Operator (2067 qso's a day/operator)

It means we are going to work DX not for party.

And now some very important words from the REBELS.

"Sincere thanks to my OH friends; OH0XX, OH1MA and our Rebel Ambassador OH2BH, who promptly responded my urgent need of amplifiers and released three (3) pcs of Juma 1000 light-weight amplifiers."

We had a plan to swap our amplifiers from heavy to light weight type. We got them in less than 3 days from Finland.

## FCC Fees

The FCC fees Report and Order adopted last December was published in the Federal Register this past week. To quote from ARRL's Legal Counsel: "I want to note to everyone that although generally the rules take effect on April 19, collection of the amateur fees will NOT begin on that date.

"The effective date for new amateur radio fees has not yet been established. The FCC explicitly states in the published Notice (at p. 15061, para. 44,

that the fees "will not take effect until the requisite notice has been provided to Congress, the FCC's information technology systems and internal procedures have been updated, and the Commission publishes notice(s) in the Federal Register announcing the effective date of such rules." I expect that the effective date will be some time this summer, but in any event we will have advance notice".

## FR - Reunion Is.

FR8UA by F5TRO, Phil, is "not a special activity," he says, as he relocates there permanently. His arrival is set for May 13 with the antennas going up within a few weeks. He plans to be equipped for 80M to 23cm. Phil's wife, Ann, is FR8TZ, ex-F5BSB, and may operate some of the time too.

## CW phishing attack

### New phishing attack uses Morse code to hide malicious URLs

Starting Feb 2nd, a threat actor began utilizing Morse code to hide malicious URLs in their phishing form to bypass secure mail gateways and mail filters. BleepingComputer could not find any references to Morse code being used in phishing attacks in the past, making this a novel obfuscation technique. The phishing attack starts with an email pretending to be an invoice for the company. The mail includes an HTML attachment named in such a way as to appear to be an Excel invoice for the company. When viewing the attachment in a text editor, you can see that it includes JavaScript that maps letters and numbers to Morse code.

The script then calls a function to decode a Morse code string into a hexadecimal string. This hexadecimal string is further decoded into JavaScript tags that are injected into the HTML page. The injected scripts combined with the HTML attachment contain the various resources necessary to render a fake Excel spreadsheet that states their sign-in timed out and prompts them to enter their password again. Once a user enters their password, the form submits the password to a remote site where the attacker can collect the login credentials. Phishing scams are becoming more intricate every day as mail gateways become better at detecting malicious emails. As this phishing email uses attachments with double-extension (xlxs and HTML), it is important to make sure that Windows file extensions are enabled to make it easier to spot suspicious attachments.

## C9 - Mozambique

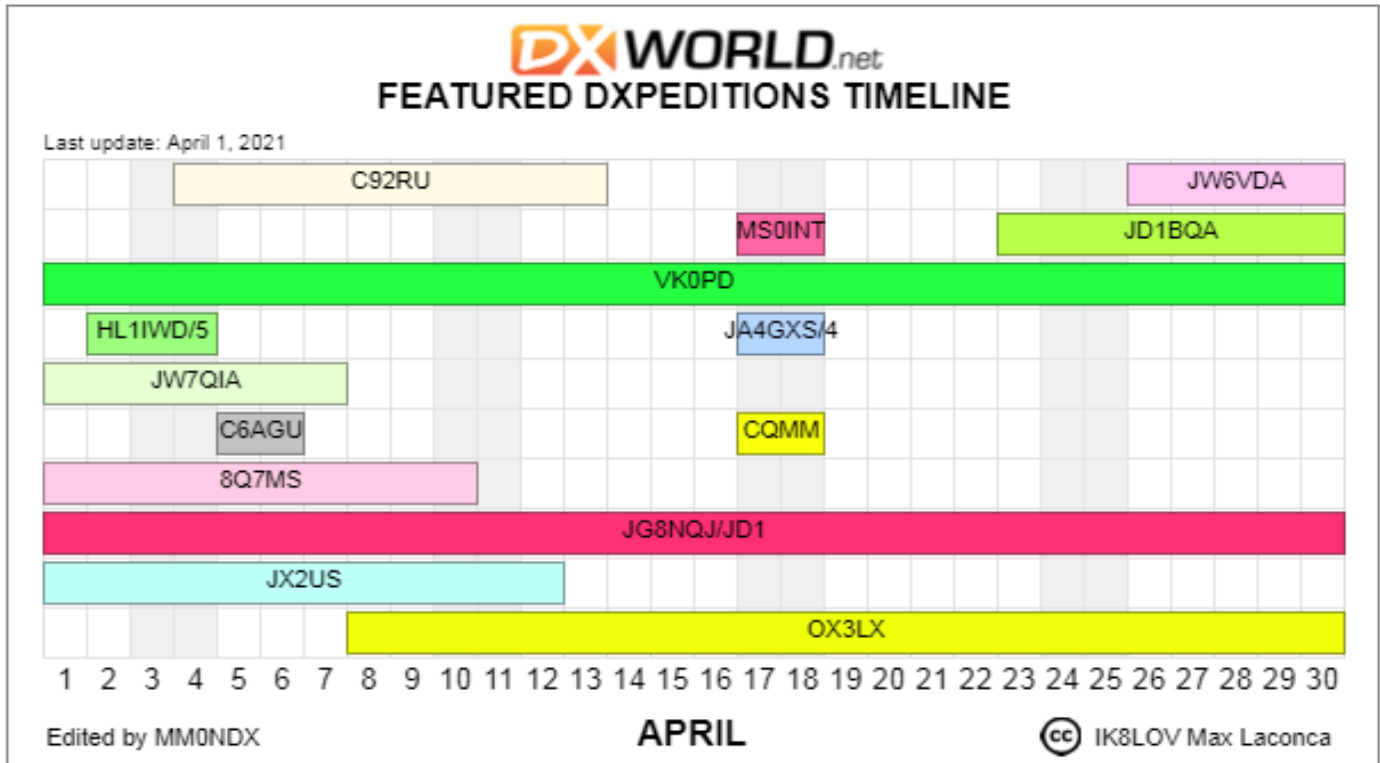
Following on their great A25RU expedition, the Russian DXpedition Team is headed to Barra Beach in Inhambane Province, Mozambique, callsign C92RU.

## FT-8 Boring Update

Last month I reported on my venture into FT-8 and the discovery of the Grid Tracker program.

So how have I done?

Well from January 1st to March 2nd: 2815 FT-8 QSO's, worked 938 grids, confirmed 696 grids, 128 DXCC entities confirmed and 141 worked on 160, 80,40,20,17,15 and 12M.

My new numbers to the end of March are: 4272 FT-8 QSO's, worked 1257 grids, confirmed 939 grids, 156 DXCC entities worked and 133 confirmed. Also 611 USA counties worked and all 50 states, 38 zones and 6 continents.

So.

What are my opinions of FT-8?

Well. If I was a beginning ham, and started off with FT-8 originally, I would probably not become a

DXer. There is just no challenge in working and confirming DXCC entities with LOTW. Mind you. There are a few entities that require forwarding funds to get a QSL card since they don't subscribe to LOTW, but certainly not to the extent of years gone by. Oh the money I could have spent on rigs instead of postage.

For the ham that has arthritic fingers and hands, FT-8 is certainly a way to stay active. Greater success of making a Q with FT-8 versus phone. Breaking through the pile ups in Fox/Hound mode is certainly easier than finding a hole on CW to throw your call into.

I achieved my original goal of making 3650 QSO's by the end of the year in less than 3 months. So now I can concentrate on something else. 6M season is just around the corner. FT-8. Here I come.
