FT8W - Crozet?

FT - French "subantarctic territories"

F5UFX Seb, has led expeditions to some of the French possessions. His group has an application in for one of these rare ones, a "French Southern Lands National Nature Reserve World Heritage site." Previous applications were turned down to concerns about the island's conservation status, the project said to be "too risky." (editors note: Seb hasn't stated which "French possession" they have an application for, but if memory serves me correctly there was mention of Crozet Island in the past. Let's keep our fingers crossed for Crozet Is.)

HR - Honduras

F2JD, Gerard, plans to be back in Copan Ruinas from December 8 to April 5. Listen for him as HR5/F2JD on CW, SSB and digital modes on all bands. QSL direct or via the bureau to F6AJA.

FT8 - Falkland Is.

Husband and wife operators VP8NX, David, and VP8VK, Suzan, are once again back on the air. The Pole-Evans are now QRV on the FT8 frequencies on 80, 40, 20 and 15 meters using a fan dipole with 20 watts.

3D2CR - Conway

The Rebel DX Group point out they had a twoman team there two yearsago. Due to covid and transportation limitations, just one op is going for this next one, with more info to come

5H - Tanzania

5H3MB is an operation by IK2GZU, Maurizio, starting September 25 and going to November 20. He has a Yaesu FT-891 and an amplifier to dipoles and a groundplane for 30M.

TL - Central Africa

TL - Central African Republic TL8AA on CW, SSB and RTTY and TL8ZZ on FT8 will be the "Italian DX Team" next spring, seven ops, four stations, 160-6M. Planned dates to follow.

3X - Guinea

Jean Philippe, F1TMY will sign 3X2021 during his upcoming visit, starting in mid-September. He will be on 160 to 6 meters and the QO-100 satellite. He will also be portable from Los Islands, IOTA AF-051. QSL through Club Log.

KH8/S - Swains

There is an upcoming W8S DXpedition to Swains Island, which is expected in "Spring 2022". This one ranks #30 on Club Log's Most Wanted DXCC list. The 10 man DXpedition team includes DL6JGN, DJ9HX, DL6KVA, DL2AMD, PA3EWP, PA4WM, PG5M, PA9M, AG4W and KO8SCA. The boat ride from American Samoa to Swains Islands is expected to take 12 hours. Plans are to have four stations operating on CW, SSB FT8 and RTTY from two camp sites.

PJ5 - St. Eustatius

PJ7JA is an expedition in October. W5JON, John, says it's been several years since PJ5, St. Eustatius, has been on. John plans on making 2-3 trips per year to PJ5 and/or PJ7.

3B8 - Mauritius

During this year's CQ World Wide DX CW Contest, along with "a few days before and after" 3B8M will be QRV.


5 Mhz DXCC?
