From the EDITORS DESK... cont'd

The Covid pandemic is still large in the news and our lives. Many of us, if not all of us, were hoping that by this point in time it would have been old news. But it appears to have raised its ugly head again, and again is impacting on our lives. This is no more evident than in the list of DXpeditions that are up coming. Two years ago, our Long Path displayed almost 4 entire pages at the back end of this publication of upcoming scheduled DXpeditions. This month it barely covers two pages. Three big DXpeditions, two to the same entity—Bouvet Island plus Crozet Island are scheduled for this year. Hopefully the Covid Grip will relax and these DXpeditions can come to fruition.

The "Periodic Table of Major Amateur Radio Contests" by EA3O for 2022 has not been published at this time. CDXA equivalent is included in this newsletter. What valuable aids these are in my opinion.

So for the start of 2022, there are already many changes. Hopefully as the year progresses the biggest change we'll see is the change of Covid from pandemic to endemic. And DX life will return to pre Covid times.

HD8M - Galapagos

The HD8M team has decided that we will not be making the DXpedition to the Galapagos Islands originally planned for March 2-12, 2022. This decision was made after much discussion and consideration and was made after consulting with persons in Ecuador who are closely attuned to the nature of the global SARS CoV-2 pandemic (aka COVID-19, aka Coronavirus) and how it is spreading there and the impact it is having on Ecuador and the Galapagos. Given all the factors, many of which are shifting rapidly, and that team members were coming from various places in North America and would therefore need to travel through multiple countries, airports, and way points in order to reach the destination, it has become clear that the risks now make it unwise to proceed at this time. The team is hoping to reschedule.

9N - Nepal

9N7AA (S53R), Robert, has gotten his Ultra Beam/WIMO two-element Yagi covering 40-6 up, on top of his new residence, about 23 meters high, "with a clear shot in all directions. He hopes his 9N station will be completely set up by mid-month. And he has worked out an arrangement with neighbors for a 160/80 sloper. He hopes he will be operational on those bands by late February.

FO/A - Austral Islands

N7QT, N6XG, DJ9RR, K5GS, W1SRD, N7BX and K0BEE are set for a DXpedition on April 16-28. They currently plan K3 and amplifier stations. Covid restrictions could affect the plans. The trip is self-funded but donations are welcome. See their wed site

JW/LB3RE, Rag plans a short operation in January 28-30 from the club station operating all bands CW.

DP0LE is a special callsign from the Arctic, aka "North Pole," in an expedition this coming April. It is very weather dependent and the schedule could change accordingly. The plans were delayed the last two years due to coronavirus. This is the third attempt by DC8TM, Thomas, and YL Martina, DF3TS.

SV/A - Mt. Athos

SV2RSG/A, Monk Iakovos has been QRVon 20 meters FT8 Fox and Hound on 14.090 MHz lately. Listen for him on 20, 40 or 160 meters. QSL via SV1RP.

PJ5 - St. Eustatius

W5JON, John Abbruscato, plans to return to Statia as PJ5/W5JON from April 26 to May 4, 2022. He will take a Yaesu FT-891, Elecraft KPA-500, Dipoles and a 3 element 6 meterYagi.

A5 - Bhutan

G4ENL, Peter, is planning to go back to Wangdue Phodrang, Bhutan next month as he is "involved with geotechnical investigations for a new dam". He will be QRV as A52CC.

3X - GUINEA

Jean-Philippe, 3X2021 is QRV from Conakry. Activity is on the HF bands. He has been QRV on 20 meters using SSB around 2100z. QSL via Clublog.

3Y0J - Bouvet Is.

We're happy to inform about some news related to the upcoming Bouvet DXpedition. (from 3Y0J web)

We have selected the Norwegian brand Arctic Lavvo who will supply us with their Venor Gamme ent. Arctic Lavvo will deliver custom made tents to the project that includes three tents for radio operation and sleeping. The manufacturer having its factory at latitude 70N is taking the extra step to ensure their high-quality products will sustain the Bouvet climate. The tent having been tested at JW Svalbard in extreme conditions up to 40 m/s will be improved further by adding extra guying levels and by strengthening the aluminium frame. We're confident selecting a Norwegian manufacturer with huge experience from this kind of climate is a wise decision.

We also would like to inform about the selection of SILCOM as the sponsor of our yagi antenna masts. SILCOM will deliver custom made antenna masts rated for the Bouvet climate. They will be named ALU-3Y0J and GLV-3Y0J where we will use the alu mast for the tribanders and the smaller steal mast for the dualbander yagis. All masts have been through detailed engineering to optimize the technical specification and rating to fit our InnovAntenna/Wimo Yagis. The masts being a square telescopic mast with tilt-over functionality and winch can easily handle 35 m/s at 10m level.

We're taking the preparation to the next level by procuring a milpro Zodiak. The strategic decision to buy the milpro Zodiak will enable us to train continuously on the critical beach landing in Norway. Having access to the exact same zodiac we will use at Bouvet, is just another step we have taken to ensure the success of this DXpedition.

We also have a change in the team. 3 team members are leaving the team due to various health and personal issues. Sandro VE7NY, Laci HA0NAR and Dima RA9USU are unfortunately leaving the team. We are happy to inform that we have already onboarded Cezar VE3LYC and Otis NP4G in the team

General Chairman Rick Allnutt, W8SG, said the earlier sales were made possible through the hard work of several of committee chairs and the Assistant General Chair, Jim Storms, AB8YK. Storms said that anyone who rolled over Hamvention tickets, booths or flea market spaces from 2020 or 2021 should have received 2022 tickets by now. WSJT-X 2.5.4, a bug-fix release correcting flaws in release 2.5.3, is now available as a General Availability (GA) release.


