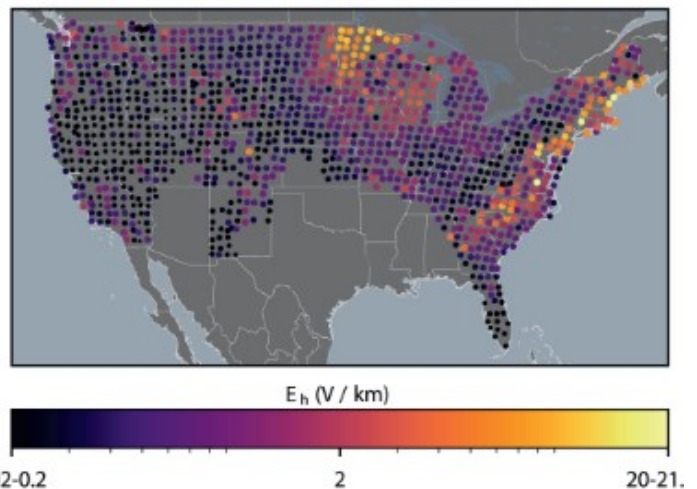
## Interesting Observation

I came across an interesting research article “Mapping a Magnetic Superstorm: March 1989 Geoelectric Hazards and Impacts on the United States Power Systems” (Here’s a [link](#) to the article). The article starts off...”A study is made of the relations between geomagnetic and geoelectric field variation, Earth-surface impedance, and operational interference (“anomalies”) experienced on electric-power systems across the contiguous United States during the 13–14 March, 1989, magnetic storm. “Following... “During the storm, anomalies were concentrated where the lithosphere is electrically resistive, and when and where geoelectric field amplitudes were high. This was particularly true in the Mid-Atlantic, Northeast, and the upper Midwest. “

What caught my eye was “electrically resistive”. I wondered why. The paper talks about ground conductivity and it appears that the east coast ground is NOT very conductive (compared to Michigan).

They go on to generate a map which I show below:

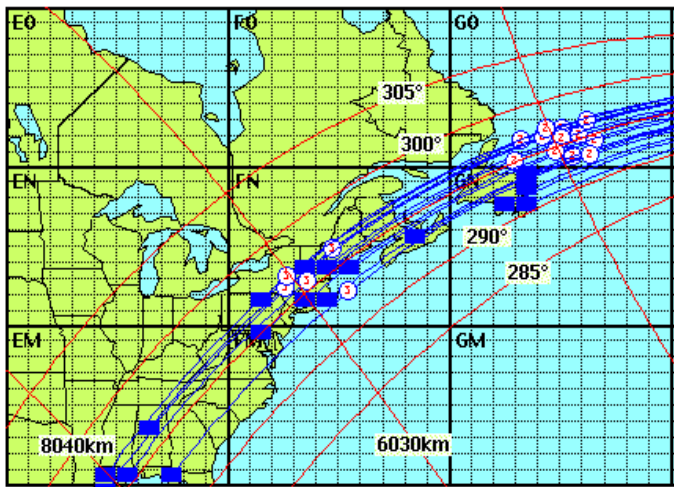
(a) Peak geoelectric amplitudes



I thought to myself “I’ve seen this pattern before”. In fact I’ve seen it many times before. It is virtually the same as the 6M propagation from the east coast of North America to Europe. See the picture on the next page.

This isn't the best map to illustrate my point, but it does convey the general idea.

Is this coincidence? I think not. I believe it is another bit of understanding at why the east coast has better propagation into Europe than Grid square EN82 exhibits

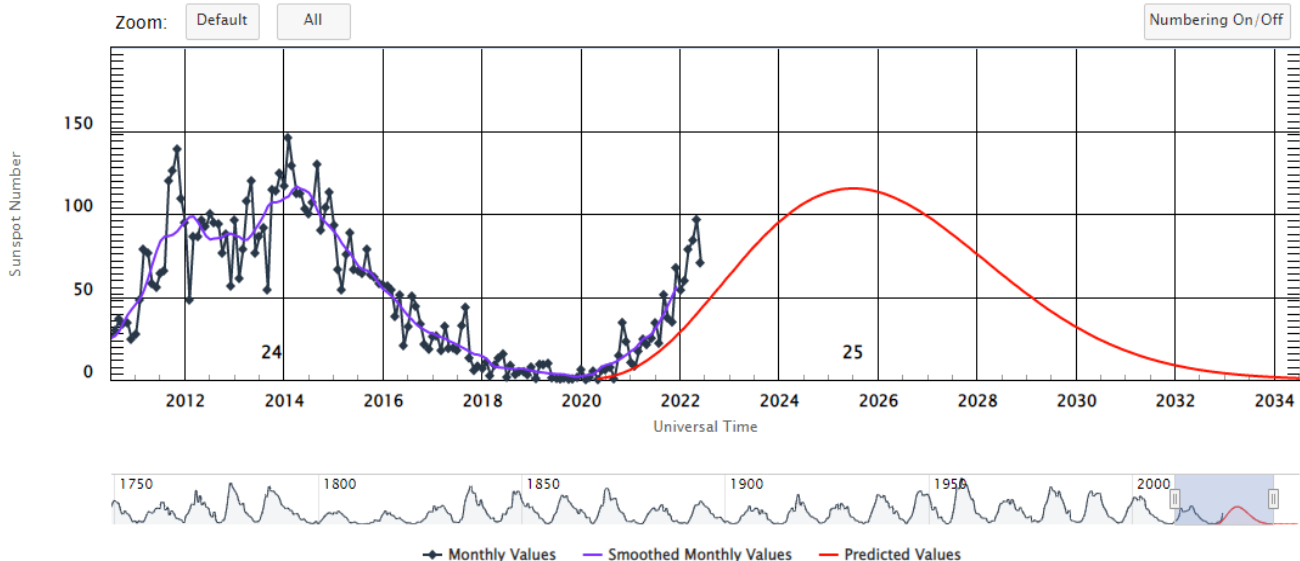

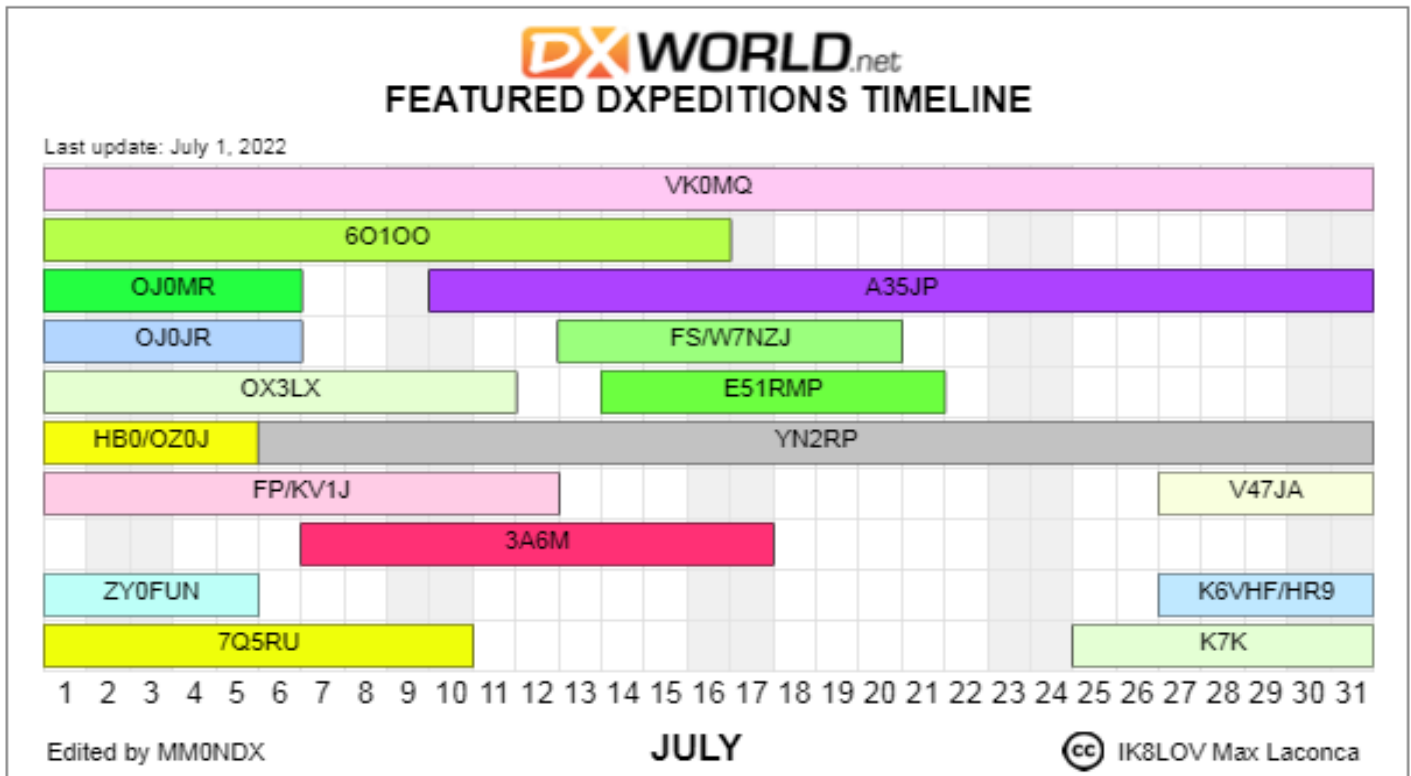
ISES Solar Cycle Sunspot Number Progression

## 1S - Spratly Is.

4F2KWT, Gil, gives us more details on the upcoming DX0NE Kalayaan, Spratly Island DXpedition, which could take place sometime between Aug 1st and Dec 31, 2022. The exact dates are dependent on a supply ship. This will be a four man team including DU1XX (AE6DG), Michael; DU3JA, Jong; 4F1OZ, Ed; and F2KWT, Gil. Plans are to have an IC-7300 and FT-991A running 100 watts into verticals (160, 80, 60 and 40 meters), VDA (30-10 meters) and a 6 Meter Yagi. Activity will be on SSB, CW and FT8 on 1.8 through 50 MHz.
