From the **Editor's** DESK



TY - Benin

From October 14 to 27 The Russian DX Team will be operating from Benin on 160-6 including 60M using 9 radios on CW, SSB, FT-8 and QO-100 satellite.

5V - Togo

The same Russian team from the above DXpedition are heading to Togo from October 28 to November 11. Much the same setup as the Benin DXpedition.

3C - Equitorial Guinea

TA2OM, Ersoy will be operating from Equitorial Guinea for several months during his work assignment there.

7Q - Malawi

K6ZO, Don Jones will be returning to Malawi on October 19 and staying until November 29th. He will be in the CWWWDX SSB and CW contests. Outside of the contests he will be on 160 to 6M.

FT#Y - Antarctica

F4FKT, David will be signing FT4YM during the December to March season. He'll be operating from Concordia Base, Little Dome Base Robert Guillard, Dumont d'Urville Base and also from L'Astrolab P800.

RI1 - Antarctica

RI1ANU from "Novolazarevskaya Station" and op ZS10IN (also ZS9Z), Oleg Neruchev, starts up October 24 and goes to March 24.

UR - Ukraine

Ukrainian authorities prohibited amateur radio operations, initially for 30 days. UR3CMA, Max, says, this now comes under the purview of martial law there. At this point there is no "centralized direct ban." The head of military administration in each region now has that decision making authority and apparently there are now no official limitations on ham radio or computer/internet communications.

VP2M - Montserrat

K2DM, George will be QRV from October 25 to November 2nd. He'll be playing in the CQ WWDX SSB contest. He'll be on all bands from 160 to 10M CW, SSB, FT4 and FT8.

CY0S - Sable Island



NEWS UPDATE – A lot of DXers have inquired about Sable Island after Hurricane Fiona made an almost direct hit on the island. Hurricane Fiona had the lowest barometric pressure (931 MB) ever recorded in Canada during any previous hurricane. Fortunately, the news is better than expected on Sable Island. Parks Canada personnel on the island report some of the buildings lost sections of siding and some roof damage. The Parks Canada personnel described the damage as superficial. The NavCan METAR (Meteorological Terminal Air Report) system was inoperative for 5-6 days until technicians could travel to the island to restore the system.

The hurricane caused some erosion and reshaped part of the island. A researcher who has been on the island for almost 50 years reported it was the worst storm she has ever experienced on the island.

C5C - The Gambia

Team C5C will again be active from Gambia during February 16 to March 13, 2023. Ops: F5RAV, 5NVF, M0NPT. QRV on HF Bands and possibly QO-100 satellite.

3D2 - Eswatini

Hans, 3DA0AQ has been QRV on 10 meters using FT8 between 1555 and 1745z.

FOR SALE

Are you ready for the Crozet and Bouvet DXpeditions.? Is your station ready? Are your antennas ready? Do you need more power? Well I may have a solution to the last question. Your editor has two (2) amplifiers for sale.

First up is a SPE Expert 1.3K solid state amplifier WITHOUT a tuner. Only used once in a 160M SSB contest, so has less than 32 hours operating time. Is in pristine condition. Comes with carrycase and original boxes Asking \$3,000.

Next up is an ACOM 2000A amplifier with a pair of 4CX800 tubes. Tubes are new. Amplifier puts out 2kW. In excellent condition. Old style, so it comes with the basic controller. Although I do have the newer 5" digital display for an additional charge. Asking \$4500.

Both amplifiers are immediately available from Chet, VE3CFK and can be delivered to your door (if you live in the Detroit area).

J5 - Guinea Bissau

Carlos, CT2GQA is QRV as J5JUA and is active until the end of 2022. Activity is mostly using FT8, and as a mobile station. He may also use J5GQA.

ZA - Albania

OE6VCG, Chris, arrived near Shkodra on October 2nd and is now QRV as ZA/OE6VCG until about October 18th. Activity will be on FT8, FT4 and JT65, normal mode and not Fox and Hound. He will QSL via eQSL and paper confirmations after he returns home.

3Y0J - Bouvet Is.

Amateur Radio DXpeditions (ARD) is making great progress for our upcoming 3Y0J Bouvet DXpedition! With only four months left until we go onshore Bouvet, we approach September that will come with two major milestones for us.

One major milestone is the shipping of the Container from Norway that is scheduled on September 18th. From Oslo the container will be shipped to Falkland Island where a team of local hams lead by Don VP8ON will make an effort to inspect the content before our arrival.

The 3Y0J team is currently busy packing all our equipment at our staging site at Oslo airport, where we for the next few weeks will finalize the packing of the equipment. This will end an extremely busy period for us.

We have been through 12 months of purchasing, assembling, testing, and packing the equipment. The team has worked hard, and ultimately shipping the container will complete this intensive period of work that will enable us to achieve our goal to activate the rare #2 DXCC Bouvetøya. Rest assured this is a well-planned DXpedition!

We have detailed out the logistic plan and have made a few changes. Among the improvements are:

We have bought yet another outboard engine enabling us to use two zodiac boats simultaneously during beach landing to speed up the unloading of gear. In addition, we have a 3rd spare zodiac and engine. Having a pair of zodiak's is a great advantage to us as we have developed a plan for going onshore Bouvet even for a short weather window down to 2h.

We have swapped the Yanmar generators with 5 kW Hyundai generators that will enable us to run full station setup with only 2 out of 4 diesel gens. It means that we are less dependent on a long duration of good weather to achieve a good setup. We have carried out a risk analysis and identified

37 hazards and assessed the risk for each hazard. 10 hazards are identified as "high" risk and 17 "medium", all which have been mitigated to an acceptable residual risk level. We have prepared a plan for rationing of food and water in case resupplies are difficult, and when we unload operators and equipment onshore Bouvet, they will be self-sufficient for 28 days without needing resupplies. The second milestone for September is the payment of the 3rd deposit for the Marama contract. This payment is a major commitment from the team and our sponsors individual and clubs, that we together

will make this happen. We thank each and every one of you who have contributed to pay a share of the vessel cost to have the opportunity to work Bouvet. We still need \$70,000 to be able to go to Bouvet. If you want to see Bouvet activated, please consider to donate.

3B9 - Rodrigues Is.

Kazu, M0CFW (JK3GAD) will be active from Rodrigues island as 3B9KW during the CQWW CW contest (November 26-27). Activity before/after contest as 3B9/M0CFW. QSL via LoTW.

3Y0J - Bouvet Is.

NEWS UPDATE by LA7GIA – This is the 4th budget update we do, and it has increased slightly up to roughly \$705,000. We have received an extremely generous support from the DX community in total \$670,000 including the operator fee, and we thus only need \$35,000 to balance.

Some of the increase is related to;

- purchasing additional outboard engine to allow 2 zodiaks to operate in parallell during beach landing. This will shorten the time we need to land the gear

- purchase of a portable Eu20i generator that will power up 230V AC tools like hammer drill, and it will also power up our fuel pump system that will pump 2000 liter of diesel from the Cape Fie beach to the generator location. Each antenna will be guyed using 4 x 15mm rebar. We will guy all outdoor equipment, tents so it will not blow away as required pr Norwegian Polar Institute regulation. In addition we have 2 large battery powered drills to help us.

- Increased logistic scope

Next up in October is;

- 2nd Vessel inspection in Brazil (close punch list, finalize vessel loading plan)

- 3 day rock climbing course in Norway



We will be guided by a glacier climber with experience from K2 THE LONG PATH


