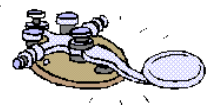

## PRES Sez

Hi all,

Welcome to March. The warm weather is finally starting to happen along with more daylight much later in the day!

From the Amateur Radio Newline Report - A proposed law has been reintroduced in Washington, D.C. to restrict the power that homeowner associations, or HOAs, have to prevent ham radio operators from installing antennas outside their residences.

This is the latest version of the Amateur Radio Emergency Preparedness Act, which has been considered by US lawmakers over the past several years without taking any action.

The measure prohibits HOAs from writing rules that ban amateur radio antennas, which are recognized as part of an essential disaster communications system for public safety. The act also provides hams with a means of resolving disputes that arise in connection with their antennas.

The sponsors are US Senators Roger Wicker, a Mississippi Republican, and Richard Blumenthal a Connecticut Democrat. Opponents of the measure in previous years have raised concerns that large antennas spoil the aesthetics of a community. Many of the measure's supporters have countered that ham radio antennas should be given the same consideration as satellite dishes and TV antennas, which many HOAs permit.

Why is this important to me...I'm getting ready to put up a tower finally. We hope one of these days Congress will vote in our favor. I did call Waterford Township and ask about putting up a "TV" antenna tower. They said no issue, can't be taller than 45 feet, setbacks are 20 feet from the side of the lot and 35 feet from the rear lot line. The only thing I can think of for both of those is if it were to fall over, it wouldn't hit anyone's house.

*Homeowners Associations (HOAs) often impose rules and regulations that govern various aspects of community living, including the installation of antennas. For amateur radio operators, these regulations can be particularly challenging. Amateur radio antennas play a crucial role in emergency communications, providing a vital service during natural disasters and other emergencies when traditional communication systems may fail. Despite this critical function, many HOAs have restrictions or outright bans on the erection of amateur radio antennas, citing concerns over the aesthetic impact on the neighborhood and property values.*

*The Amateur Radio Emergency Preparedness Act aims to address these concerns by prohibiting HOAs from implementing rules that ban amateur radio antennas. The act acknowledges the importance of these antennas as part of an essential disaster communications system for public safety. It provides a means for amateur radio operators, also known as "hams", to resolve disputes that may arise with HOAs regarding their antennas. By promoting a balance between community aesthetics and the necessity of emergency preparedness, the act seeks to ensure that amateur radio operators can continue to provide their valuable services without undue restrictions.*

*Supporters of the measure argue that amateur radio antennas should receive the same consideration as satellite dishes and TV antennas, which are commonly allowed by HOAs. They emphasize that the benefits of having a robust emergency communication system far outweigh the potential visual drawbacks. Opponents, however, remain concerned about the potential impact on the appearance of their communities. As the debate continues, amateur radio operators remain hopeful that lawmakers will recognize the importance of their contributions to public safety and enact legislation that supports their ability to operate freely and effectively.*

## VU4 - Andaman Is



As March approached, excitement grew immensely. We did encounter serious challenges in recent weeks, facing enormous stress and unexpected obstacles that no one foresaw. But we are determined and never give up with the goal of ‘completing our mission...’

In the recent months, significant changes have been made to the legislation for radio amateurs in India. We were unsure whether these changes would impact our DXpedition, so we reached out to the Ministry of Communications in New Delhi. The WPC confirmed that the new regulations did indeed apply to us, meaning we had to reapply for our VU4 license. We quickly gathered all the required documents from everyone and submitted a new application. A few weeks later, we received our new license this time with the callsign VU4AX instead of VU4X.

Although we did our best to regain the VU4X callsign, we were unsuccessful. Many key officials responsible for granting licenses were occupied with the parliamentary elections in early February, making communication extremely difficult.

We couldn't afford to wait any longer, as the risk of not receiving the new license in time had become too great. There was still a lot to do, such as making polo shirts, flags, banners, and more. Another major challenge was quickly adapting the DX-Adventure website to reflect the new callsign, VU4AX.

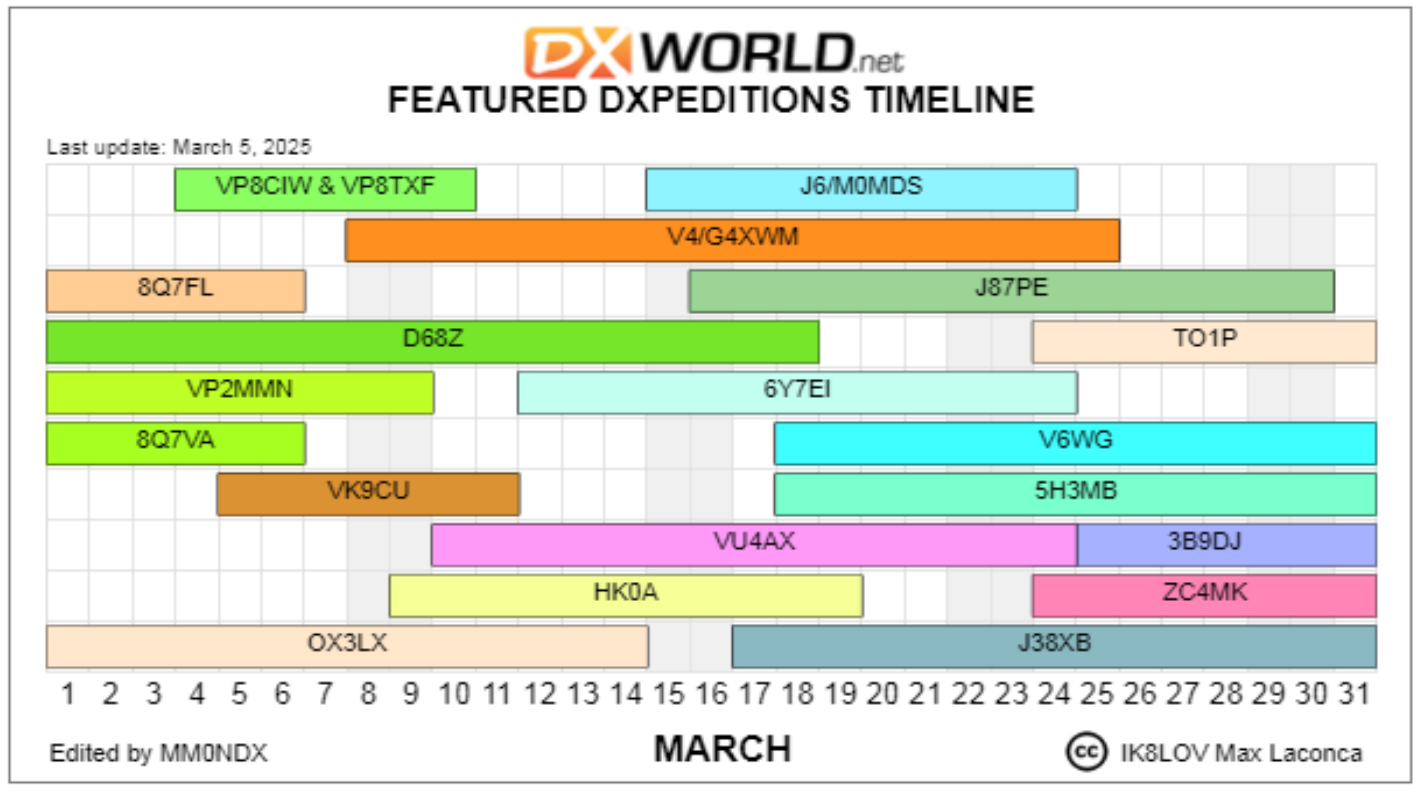

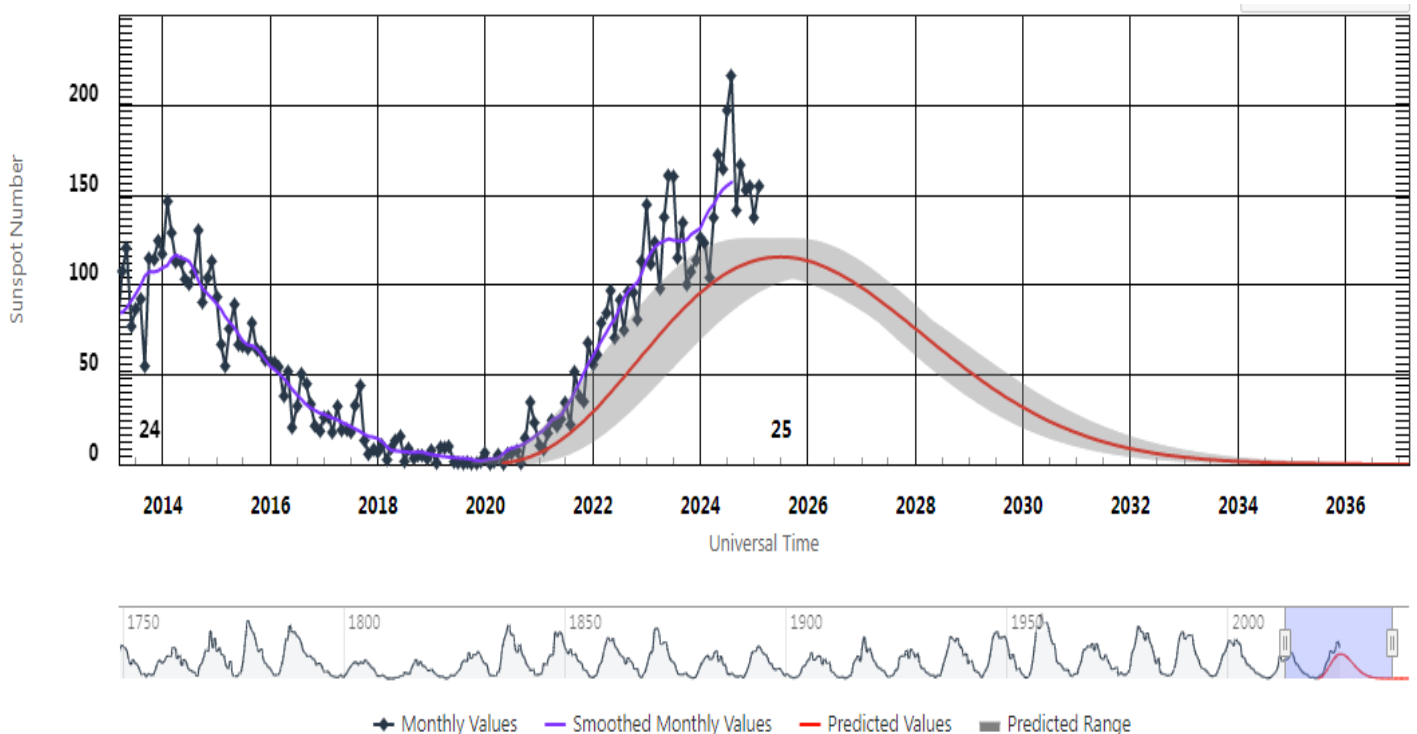
