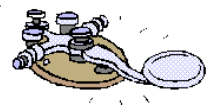

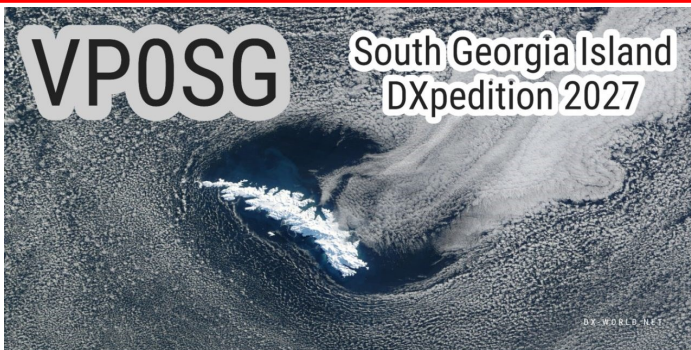

If you cannot attend, please ZOOM. ZOOM access is posted elsewhere in this newsletter. See you there.

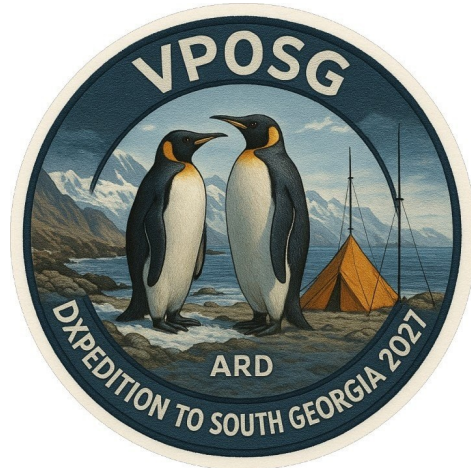
## VP0 - S. Georgia



**Amateur Radio DXpeditions (ARD) is proud to announce plans for a groundbreaking DXpedition to South Georgia Island, set to take place in March 2027.**

Operating under the allocated callsign VP0SG, this ambitious activation will target one of the rarest and most logistically challenging DXCC entities, well ranked on top of the Club Log's Most Wanted List, with particularly high demand in some areas of the world.

The remote sub-Antarctic island of South Georgia poses access difficulties due to its protected environmental status, mountainous terrain, and volatile weather conditions. After extensive negotiations and ongoing permitting discussions with the Government of South Georgia & the South Sandwich Islands (GSGSSI), ARD is optimistic about securing authorization for an onshore operation.



The team has reserved a rugged, ice-strengthened expedition motor vessel known for its support of polar science missions for the period of the DXpedition to South Georgia. The ship's versatility and compact size make it an ideal platform for staging low-impact landings and providing continuous logistical support to the operator team.

"Our goal is to deliver a world-class, environmentally responsible DXpedition with global reach" said Rune LA7THA, one of the ARD leadership team. "This project combines technical innovation, strategic planning, and a strong commitment to youth mentorship."

As a project that aligns closely with the values of international amateur radio collaboration, education, and high-impact DXing, ARD is currently seeking sponsorship and support from key organizations in the amateur radio community to bring VP0SG to life.

All 3Y0K antennas are generously provided by Krassy K1LZ. The team has chosen to use monobander antennas for 20, 15 and 10m. These will be 3 el on 20m, 4 el on 15m and 5 el on 10m. All antennas manufactured in Bulgaria and custom made for Bouvetøya with low weight, but high strength. High gain monobanders and Acom amplifiers will give us a good signal all over the world. With two radio tents and 8 stations as a realistic setup, the plans for building the camp are materializing. The team is putting in a lot of hours into making this DXpedition a success.

### ZS8W - Marion Is

Yuris, YL2GM / ZS8W has submitted all documentation to ARRL DXCC and is awaiting approval. Meantime, he has requested a LoTW certificate and is planning to upload QSOs [to there] after June 15th. QSL cards have also been received from the printer.

Participants will receive certificates showing their score and rank in various categories. Submission will be made via the DX Marathon website's submission tool by the following Sunday after the sprint ends. If successful, this sprint may become a recurring event.

## VQ9 to 3B8



The UK has announced it is giving up sovereignty of a remote but strategically important cluster of islands in the Indian Ocean after more than half a century. The deal – reached after years of negotiations – will see the UK hand over the Chagos Islands to Mauritius in a historic move. This includes the tropical atoll of Diego Garcia, used by the US government as a military base for its navy ships and long-range bomber aircraft.

On May 22, 2025 the UK signed a deal to hand over the Chagos Islands to Mauritius. So there may very well be a new DXCC entity!!!!

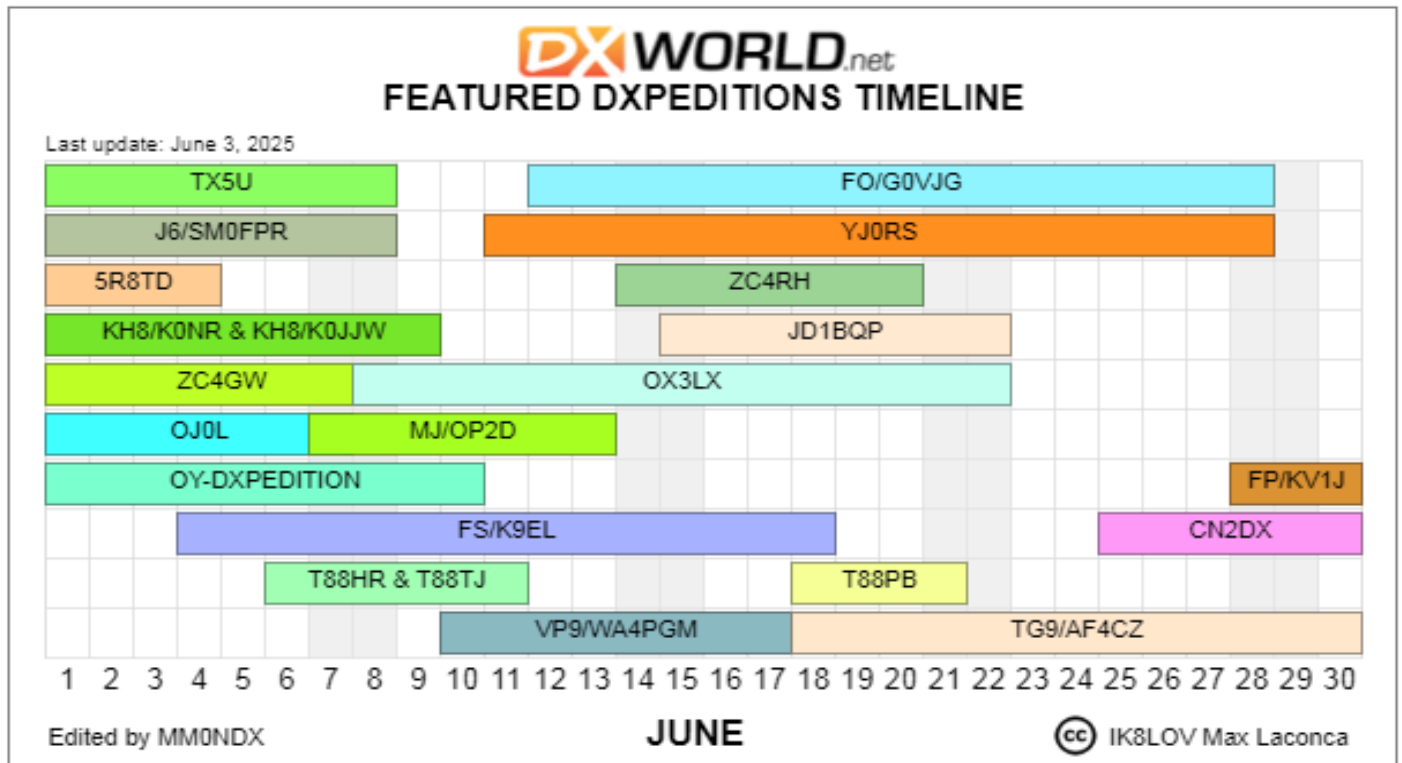

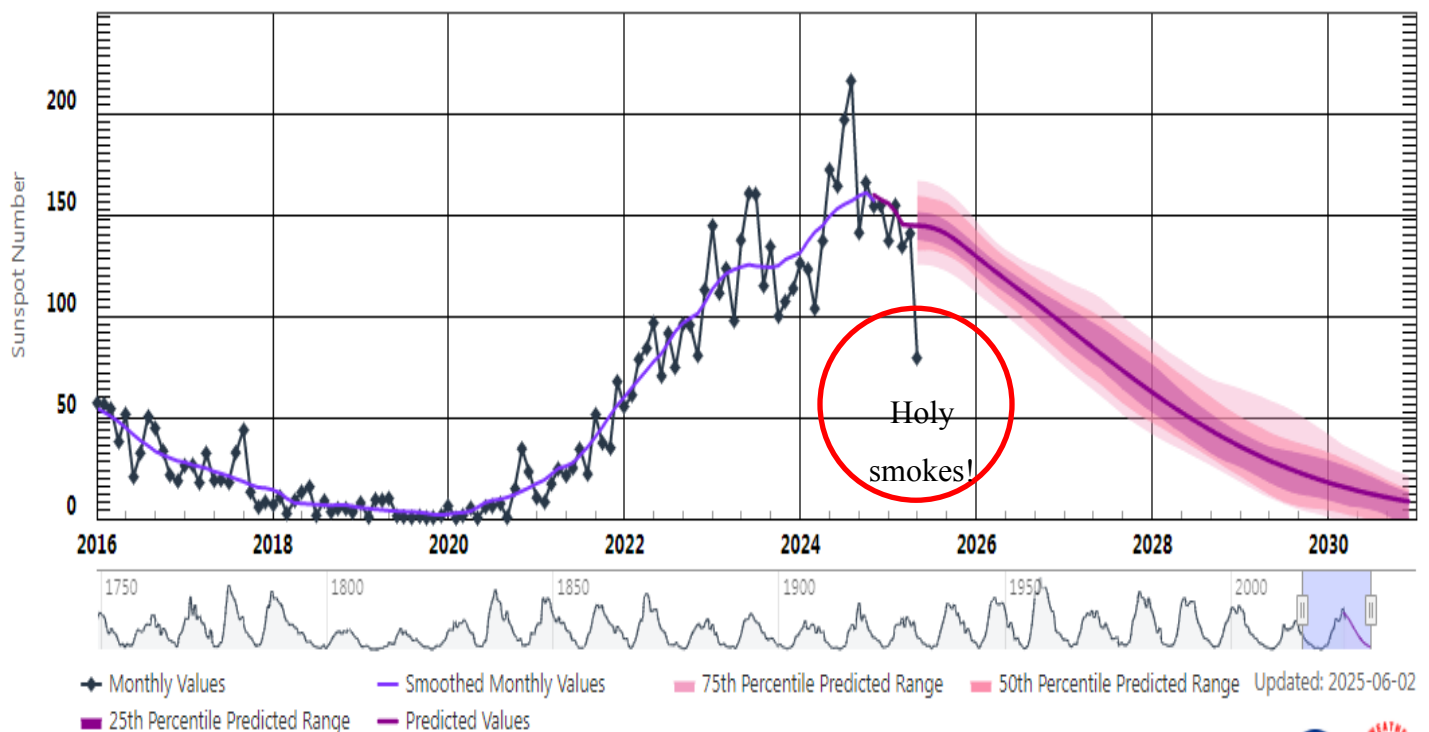
